Email Usage Finder

Those nice people at Epieos have added a new Email Usage Finder search function to their online resource, to go alongside their Google Account Finder & Phone Account Finder.

At <u>https://tools.epieos.com/holehe.php</u> you can freely and easily search an email address to see if it is linked to a number of online sites, including Twitter, RocketReach (which is a Linkedin third-party site), OK (the Russian version of Facebook), Google and Amazon as well as a few others.

Whilst they might not provide a direct link to the account the email address is linked to, this is a quick way of finding out if enquiries are going to prove positive anyway.

WhatsMyName

The useful people search site at <u>https://whatsmyname.app/</u> have added a new search function to it, so if you are searching an online screenname / username, it will now also search it against a number of online political sites, adding it to the list of sites it already checks.

So using<u>https://whatsmyname.app/</u> you can search an online screenname / username against a number a categories on over 250 sites, showing the results online but letting you easily save them as a pdf or spreadsheet.

These full list of categories searched against include;

YouTube Meta Data

Well it's called YouTube Meta Data but it's not Meta Data as in what is often shown in relation to digital images but the site at <u>https://mattw.io/youtube-metadata/</u> is still very helpful.

By adding the URL / web address of any YouTube video it will then reveal everything about a video and it's channel that is available from the YouTube API, providing useful processing of dates, country codes, language codes, geolocation, as well screengrabs which can be used in reverse image searches.

Corporate Wiki Links

The site at <u>https://www.corporationwiki.com/</u> allows you to search for relationships & links between companies and people, identifying known addresses, phone numbers, and more.

TFL JamCams

<u>https://www.tfljamcams.net/</u> is a section of the Transport For London site, with a map showing the locations of all the TFL traffic cameras, which can be viewed in real-time and which each have a 3 month archive of still images, taken every 6 minutes for each camera.
